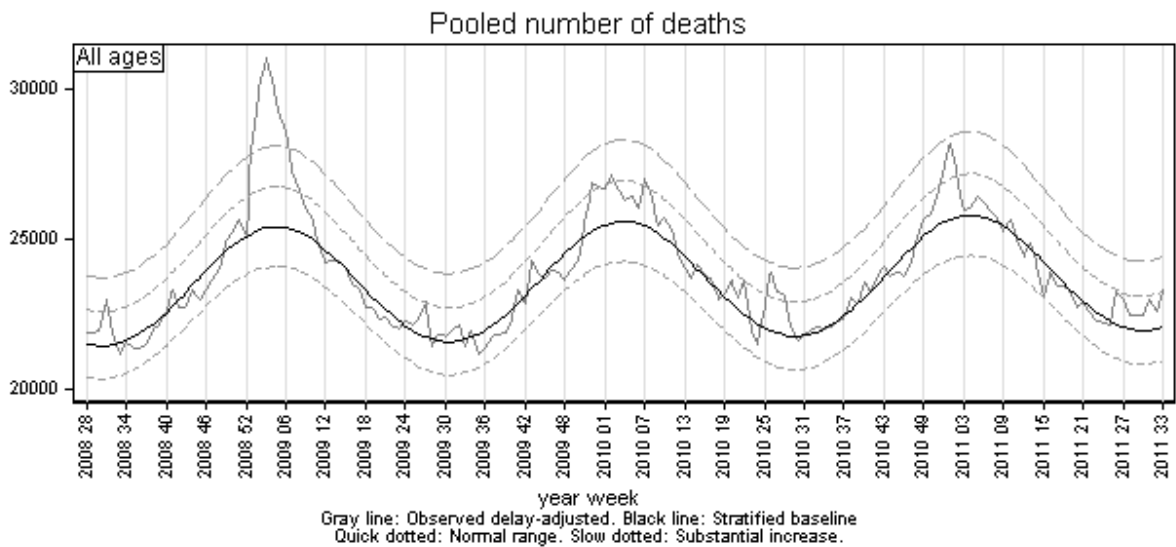
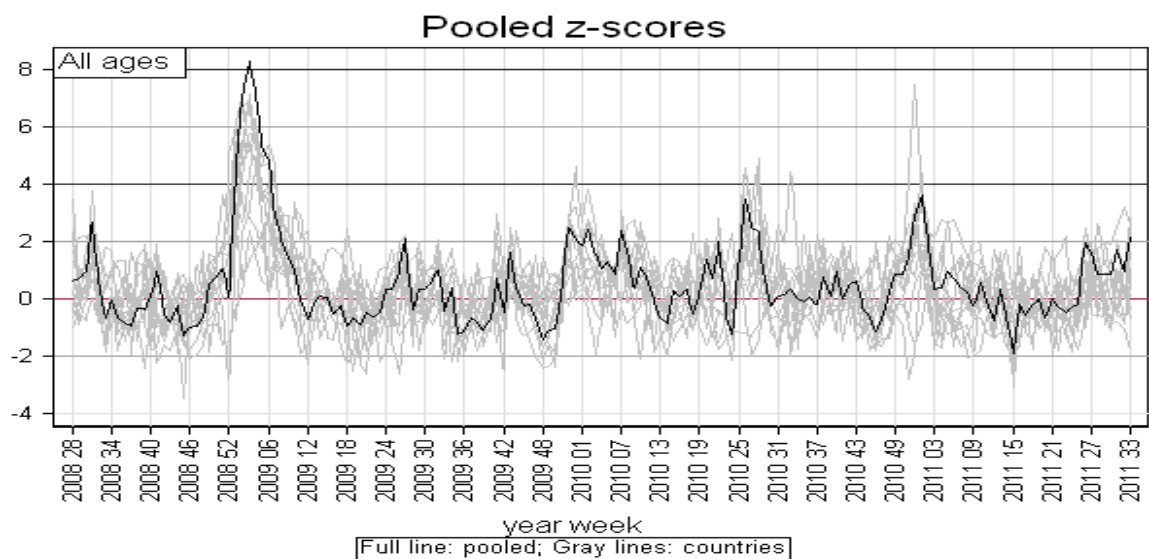


European mortality bulletin week 33, 2011: Mortality has since the middle of January been within the normal range for all countries. However, it has been increased over the last two month.

Over the last months, all-cause number of deaths, corrected for delay in local reporting of deaths, has been below 2 z-scores; except over the last months where the pooled number of deaths has been increased, mainly in the southern and south-western part of Europe. A pattern also observed previous years and probably associated to weather conditions (heat waves).
