
European monitoring of excess mortality for public health action

European mortality bulletin week 10, 2012: All-cause mortality among the 65+ year olds is increased in the pooled analysis of European countries submitting data this week. Excess mortality is detected since week 5. Because data from week 10 are likely to be influences by reporting delay, we do not know if excess mortality has peaked yet. It is also too early to assess the magnitude of this year's excess. The excess mortality concurs with elevated influenza activity in Europe as well as with a cold snap that affected Europe in the beginning of February.
