

**European mortality bulletin week 15, 2012:** All-cause mortality among the 65+ year olds has decreased back to normal levels. Excess mortality had been above 3 z-scores from the baseline between week 5 to 11 2012 (peak in week 7 2012). The excess mortality concurred with increased influenza activity in Europe as well as with a cold snap that affected Europe in the beginning of February. The cumulative number of excess deaths among 65+ year olds lies above levels of the 2009/2010 and 2010/2011 season but below the number of excess deaths in the 2008/2009 pre-pandemic season.
