
European mortality bulletin week 16, 2012: All-cause mortality among the 65+ year olds has decreased back to normal levels. Excess mortality had been above 3 z-scores from the baseline between week 5 to 11 2012 (peak in week 7 2012). The excess mortality concurred with increased influenza activity in Europe as well as with a cold snap that affected Europe in the beginning of February. The mortality peak in week 11 the 5-14 year age group reflects the death of 21 Belgium children a bus accident
