
European mortality bulletin week 18, 2012: All-cause mortality is within normal levels in the pooled analysis of 11 European countries. Excess mortality among the elderly had peaked between week 5 to 11 2012. This excess mortality concurred with increased influenza activity in Europe as well as with a cold snap that affected Europe in the beginning of February. The mortality peak in week 11 in the 5-14 year age group reflects the death of 21 Belgium children a bus accident

The pooled analyses, based on eleven countries, were adjusted for differences in local delay of reporting and heterogeneities in pattern and variation between the included countries.
