

European monitoring of excess mortality for public health action

European mortality bulletin week 23, 2012: Pooled all-cause mortality among elderly (aged 65 or more) has over the last weeks been above the upper limit of the expected range for this time of the season. However, there is a considerable variation between the countries, and excess mortality has been seen in a few countries only (most of the gray lines are around 0 on the z-score graph). No clear reason for this has been identified. The development is followed intensively.
