
There has been observed a slight increased mortality among elderly in Spain and Portugal since the beginning of July, both concurrent with high temperatures.

Data from 15 countries or regions* were received this week and included in the pooled analyses.

Excess mortality levels in most recent weeks may be difficult to interpret because adjustment for delayed registrations may be imprecise. Further, results of pooled analyses may vary depending on which countries were included in the weekly analyses. Pooled analyses are adjusted for variation between the included countries and for differences in the local delay in reporting. Further details are available on http://www.euromomo.eu
