
European Mortality Bulletin, week 2 2019:


Pooled estimates of all-cause mortality show mortality levels within normal expected ranges in the participating countries overall. However, a few countries are starting to observe some excess mortality in their elderly populations.

Data from 23 countries or regions were included in this week's pooled analysis of all-cause mortality.

The number of deaths in the recent weeks should be interpreted with caution as adjustments for delayed registrations may be imprecise. Furthermore, results of pooled analyses may vary depending on countries included in the weekly analyses.
